

VISITOR INFORMATION



Designed by Arthur Vernon Macan in 1913, Royal Colwood is a traditional-style parklands championship course set amongst 450-year-old Douglas firs and majestic Garry oaks. One of a select few in the world, Royal Colwood received its Royal designation from King George V in 1931. Royal Colwood has been privileged to play host to royalty, celebrities, sports stars, and the general golfing public.

On behalf of our team at Royal Colwood Golf Club, we look forward to your visit. To help prepare you for your visit, please take note of our local guidelines and traditions:

Arrival- Please be aware of the 1st green on your left and the 2nd tee on your right. We ask that you wait until the group on the green or tee has waved you through to drive forward. Upon arrival, please check in at the pro-shop located next to our first tee. All visitors have access to complimentary driving range balls and use of the practice putting, chipping, and wedge game areas.

Attire- Traditional golf shirts, slacks, skirts, and shorts may be worn. Golf shoes may not have metal spikes. Please go to www.royalcolwood.org for a complete description of our dress code under the Visitor Information section.

Pace of Play- All players must keep pace with the group ahead and complete 18 holes in 4 hours or less.

Course Notes- We ask that all members and visitors leave the golf course in better condition than they found it. Please repair all ball marks and divots. Golf Cart traffic should be focused on fairways and cart paths. Please keep carts a minimum of 30 feet from all greens. Please note that push carts are not allowed between the bunkers and the greens.

Cellular Phones- Cell phones for the purpose of texting or emailing are permissible on club property. Cell phones shall be switched to vibrate or silent while visiting our Club. If you must make or accept a phone call, please note there are designated areas inside the Clubhouse for this purpose. Talking on a cell phone is prohibited on the practice facilities and inside the Clubhouse not designated as a cell phone usage area.

ROYAL COLWOOD DRESS CODE

Acceptable golf course attire

- Collared, turtleneck, mock-neck golf shirts are to be worn tucked-in
- Full-length button-down shirts may remain untucked
- Women's tops with either collar or sleeves
- Golf-branded pants or tailored slacks and shorts
- Golf skorts and skirts as high as fingertips reach
- Soft spike golf shoes, golf boots, or golf sandals
- Golf or sports hats and visors keeping the peak forward
- Subtle sports or corporate logos
- Hooded sweatshirts golf or Royal Colwood branded

Unacceptable golf attire

- Denim, cargo shorts, leggings/athletic bottoms (can be worn under skort/skirt) or swimwear, T-shirts, hoodies without a golf brand or club brand, track pants or sweat pants
- Flip-flops

Acceptable clubhouse attire

- Golf attire
- Denim without tears
- Golf shoes are permitted in the upper clubhouse from April August
- Leather sandals, deck shoes, and slip-ons with socks
- Hats may be worn on the lower floor (with the exception of the lower 19th) and the patio

Junior/Juniors:

- RCGC recognizes that children's clothing can vary from adults, and some tolerance will be permitted for children less than 12 years of age provided their attire is in good taste and in nice fashion. We encourage juniors to dress appropriately.
